Short CV

He is the president of the RCOST and the Asia Pacific Hip Society (APKS).

He graduated from the Faculty of Medicine, Chulalongkorn University in 1986. Thereafter, he underwent fellowship training in adult hip and knee reconstruction at Baylor College, Houston; in knee reconstruction at the Insall-Scott-Kelly Institute for Orthopaedics and Sports Medicine, Beth Israel Medical Center, NY; and in knee reconstruction and minimally invasive arthroplasty at the Institute for Advanced Orthopaedic Study, Robert-Wood Johnson Medical School, New Brunswick, USA. He has taught and practiced at his institution since 1999, receiving full professor appointment in 2011.

A world-renowned authority on joint replacement, Professor Tanavalee is the researcher and the author of numerous articles on knee and hip arthroplasty which have appeared in national and international peer-reviewed journals. In addition, he has written several local and international book chapters on joint replacement.
