Dr Badrul Shah Badaruddin completed his undergraduate medical training and postgraduate Orthopaedic training at National University of Malaysia (UKM) with Master in Orthopaedic Surgery in 1998. Dr Badrul went on and completed an advanced trauma Fellowship in St George's Hospital in London in the year 2000. He then became a member of the Academy of Medicine, Malaysia in 2001. In early 2002, he undertook an Australian Orthopaedic Association accredited Arthroplasty & Arthroscopy Fellowship attachment in Monash Medical Centre, Melbourne. Later on, he went to Adelaide to further subspecialize in Revision Joint Replacement Surgery at Royal Adelaide Hospital.

Dr Badrul returned to Malaysia in 2003 and was appointed as Head of Joint Replacement Unit in Hospital Kuala Lumpur (HKL) from 2003 till 2007. Apart from general orthopaedic & traumatology, he also specializes in the treatment of arthritis e.g. from conservative, arthroscopic to primary & revision joint replacement surgeries. He practices the current trends of minimally invasive surgeries, computer aided total knee surgeries & direct anterior approach for total hip replacement surgeries. Since early 2011, he was accredited for Custom-Made Instrumentation Total Knee Replacement Surgery as well as Oxford Partial Knee Replacement. He is also trained in Robotic Partial Knee Replacement Surgery, Makoplasty & performed these surgeries in Prince Court Medical Centre (PCMC) since 2013. Apart from Arthroplasty he is also specialise in Arthroscopic surgery for Anterior Cruciate Ligament (ACL) injury, meniscus injury and also shoulder impingement problems.

Dr Badrul is a Life Member of Malaysian Orthopaedic Association (MOA) and Malaysian Arthroscopy Society. He has been in the council of MOA for many years before he became the President from 2015-2016.
