## Short CV

He has been an active member of the APOA since induction in 1979 when it was still known as the WPOA. During his POA Presidency in 1987, the POA hosted the successful 25th WPOA Silver Anniversary in Manila, Philippines. During the 1990's, he was active as one of the charter members of the APOSSM (sports) & the APKS (Knee Society) with the late Prof. Tomihisa Koshino. Under his leadership, the POA also hosted the Combined POA 50th Golden /AOA/APOA Congress 1999 in Manila. It was during this time that the then WPOA President Robert Bauze initiated the change to the name APOA during the Council meeting. He was a long time APOA Chief Delegate of Philippines. In 2016, he spearheaded the Philippines' successful bid to host the APOA 2022. This will be held in Manila in November 2022. He is the current Chairman of APOA Membership Committee 2018-2020.

He has been with the UP College of Medicine-Philippine General Hospital, Dept of Orthopaedics, since he returned from a 3 years Fellowships Training in Orthopaedic Trauma & Joint Arthroplasty at the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre in Oxford. He had mandatory retirement from the University where he was Professor & Chairman of the Department, but retained his honorary/Emeritus position.

He is still active in private clinical practice. He is the Founding Chairman of the Dept. of Orthopaedics, Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital. He is also an Emeritus Orthopaedic Consultant at both the San Juan de Dios Hospital and the ASIAN Hospital & Medical Center. His present interest includes Osteoporosis, Pain/Arthritis Management. He is active in the International Orthopaedic community as an invited speaker in forums & congresses.
